How does your college measure the impact of quality initiatives? What evidence is used to show the college is supporting its mission? In this panel presentation, learn about using benchmarking data as part of your accreditation process. Metropolitan and Johnson County Community Colleges will share how they used benchmarking data from the Benchmarking Institute and other sources to provide evidence in support of the accreditation criteria with innovative metrics and data visualizations. Additionally, NHEBI has mapped their data to HLC and SACS accreditation criteria, and this will be shared with attendees.

The Equality of Opportunity Project found that students' prospects of earning more than their parents declined from 90% to 50% over the past 50 years. The Project collected income data for 30 million students/parents & devised mobility reports for colleges which are incorporated into 2017 NCCBP. The index represents the likelihood a student at a specific college will move up two or more income quintiles. Mobility data for specific colleges and how it relates to other NCCBP benchmarks will be shared. National and additional regional mobility data will also be included.
